8 Consultant Practitioner

“Staff working at a very high level of clinical expertise and/or have responsibility for planning of services.”

But how do we get there?

Four Domains

- Expert clinical practice
- Education
- Leadership
- Service development (research and audit)

Key working relationships. NHS Education South Central

- Consultant Nurses
- ENP/ECP
- Nursing team
- ED Consultants
- Senior management

Typical week

- 50% In placement:
 - 2 days clinical service delivery
 - ½ day Extending own clinical skills
- 1 academic day
 - Masters, DCLinP or PhD
- Flexible day – use negotiated, depending on learning needs

Assessment

- Learning outcomes set for each year
- Agree learning needs at start of placement
- Complete two service development projects
- Mini-CEX
- Annual portfolio review
