NHS apprenticeships – the year in figures

Largest employer in England **1.2m** employees*

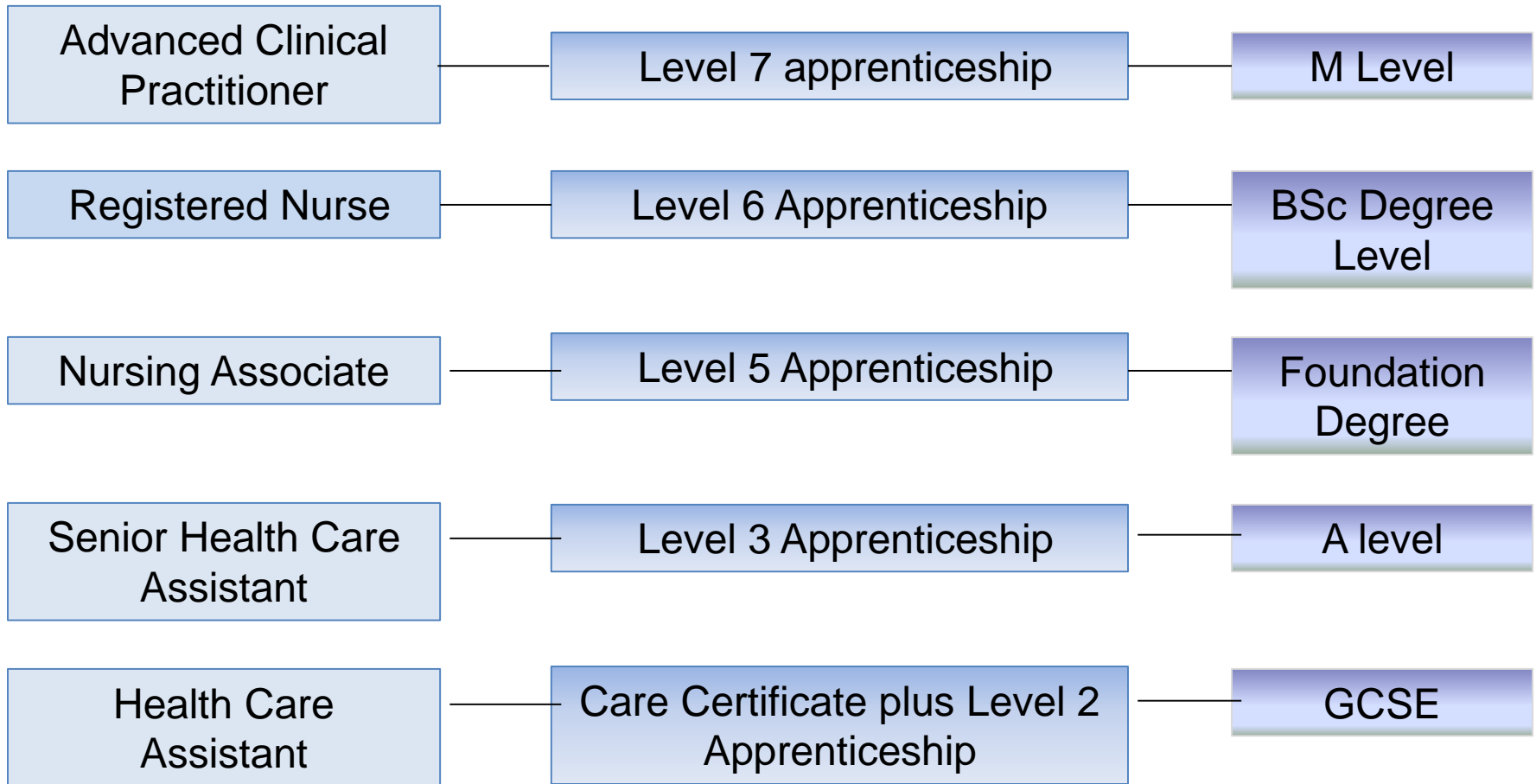
Expected to deliver **1/3** of public sector apprenticeships
83% achieved in 18/19 – 23,200 starts

Combined levy **£200m** each year

To deliver **28,500** new apprenticeship starts including
5,000 Nursing Associate apprenticeships (18/19)
7,500 in 19/20

Trailblazer Update

- L7 Specialist Community and Public Health Nurse (SCPHN) apprenticeship standard approved £13,000 funding band
- NMC approved
- No starts until EPAO in principle
- L7 District Nurse Apprenticeship – first starts planned for September 2020
- Specialist Clinical Practitioner – proposal approved – will include all routes of Nursing & Critical Care including NICU & PICU
- L5 Health Play Specialist – ready for delivery
- L8 Clinical Academic Fellow – in development
