April 2023 - September 2023

1. UKHSA and BASHH Syphilis Summit

In September 2023 Belinda Loftus represented the RCN at The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) and British Association for Sexual Health & HIV (BASHH) Syphilis Summit. Belinda is a member of the RCN public health forum and a link nurse and has a long, and established career in Sexual Health. UKHSA data showed a worrying increase in syphilis cases, with an increase in reports of late diagnoses, complex cases and concerns about severe and irreversible harm to those affected. The syphilis summit was a roundtable event with representatives from key specialties to:

- Raise awareness of the current situation for syphilis in England.
- Raise awareness of where and how cases may present and how best to manage (potential) cases.
- Agree what action needs to be taken across a range of healthcare settings and specialties.

What has been the impact or difference made as a result of the member representation?

1. UKHSA and BASHH Syphilis Summit

- This meeting was a call to arms rather than the end point and ensured there was nursing representation and will continue to be RCN engagement in this field of work.
- Attendance informed the RCN's work and clinical, now ELD, pages on sexual health.
- Updates were shared widely across relevant RCN colleagues.
- Future opportunities to facilitate the following, aimed at nurses who work in fields outside sexual health services, include, podcasts, articles in general nursing press and webinars.
