

## **Displaced People Cadet Scheme**

The RCN is offering an opportunity to displaced people in Wales who are refugees or asylum seekers to explore healthcare as a potential career. It doesn't matter if you arrived in Wales recently or some years ago. With 350 roles in the NHS, there is likely to be a role perfect for you.

### Programme aims to:

- Give an insight into healthcare and healthcare careers in Wales.
- Develop your knowledge of healthcare issues such as resilience, teamworking communication.
- Make you aware of careers in the health sector in Wales.
- Prepare you for observational work experience through practical learning, for example basic life support, manual handling and infection control.
- Coach for and experience a simulated healthcare interview.
- Help develop a draft personal statement and CV to support applications for roles in NHS Wales.

The programme includes 25-20 hours of workplace experience in a local NHS Trust in Wales. Expenses available for travel to and from placement. We have some hardship funds for the in person programme for travel to attend.
