NIHR research funding opportunities

The National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) funds research through its nine programmes, which include Health Technology Assessment (HTA) and Health Services and Delivery Research (HSDR).

- COVID-19: recovery and learning, closes 14 July.
- Programme grants for applied research (competition 33), closes 29 July.
- Qualitative research on women's experiences of urogynaecological health services, closes 1 September.
- Researcher-led workstream (HSDR), closes 10 September.
- Evidence synthesis programme grant scheme, closes 12 October.
