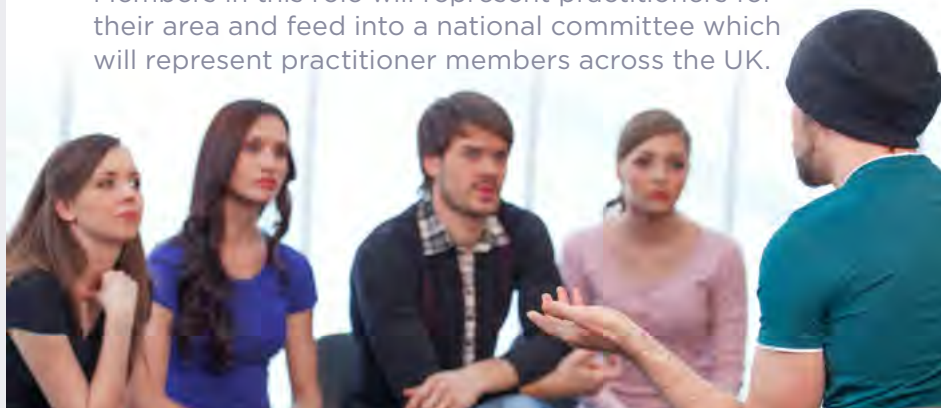
You are welcome to join FPH as a Practitioner Member and receive all of the benefits of membership available if you are registered with any of the following organisations:
