RESOLUTION:

We have no confidence in the current leadership of the Royal College of Nursing and call on Council to stand down

As scrutineers for the vote taken on the above Resolution proposed at the Extraordinary General Meeting of members of the Royal College of Nursing on 28th September 2018 **we hereby certify** that the result of the vote on the above Resolution is as follows:

The number voting AGREE with the Resolution	11,153	(78.1%)
The number voting DISAGREE with the Resolution	3,124	(21.9%)
The total number of votes cast	14,277	(100.0%)
Fifty percent of 14,277 is	7,138.5	

Therefore there **is** a fifty percent majority and the Resolution **is** carried.

We hereby certify that the Resolution has been passed by the requisite majority of Royal College members voting (in person or by proxy) to Agree with the Resolution.

Although they do not constitute valid votes and have not been included there were 1,112 abstentions. There were no spoilt papers.
