The National Institute for Health Research Dissemination Centre (NIHR DC) critically appraises the latest health research to identify the most reliable, relevant and significant findings. Recent examples include:

- nurse staffing levels linked to reports of missed care in adult wards
- comprehensive assessment may reduce risk of delirium after hip fracture
- humidified oxygen linked to increased chest infections
- music can reduce pain and anxiety following surgery
- varicose vein injections help new venous leg ulcers heal.
