Renewing loans online

You can avoid library charges by renewing your loans online. Items can be renewed up to three times as long as they are not reserved by another member. This step-by-step guide shows how to renew loans. If you have any questions please get in touch with us.

Step 1

Go to www.rcn.org.uk/library and the library homepage opens.



Step 2

Scroll down the library homepage to the Library services box and click on Renewals.



Step 3

On the next screen click on **Renew My Materials**.



Step 4

You will be asked to enter your **RCN membership number** followed by a **PIN**. The default PIN number is **9999**.



Enter these details and click on List Loaned Items.

Step 5

The items loaned to you are now displayed. Select **Renew All** to renew everything on your account and then **Renew Selected Items**.
