

2019 Brownlee-Silverdale Leadership Award Entry Form



The RCN Northern Ireland Nurse of the Year Awards will take place on 6 June 2019 at the Culloden Hotel.

The Brownlee-Silverdale Leadership Award is open to registered nurses working in a leadership role in health and social care or the independent sector in Northern Ireland.

Candidates must demonstrate that, through good leadership of nursing staff, they have improved services for patients or clients.

How to apply

Complete the nomination form and a 500 word summary of how the nominee meets the following criteria:

- That they have excelled in a strategic leadership role and are recognised by colleagues and senior management for this

- Demonstrates that they are an ambassador who can work across all disciplines and influence in a strategic manner, respecting others
- They are a strategic nurse leader who can be visionary and demonstrates innovation and creativity
- They are a reflective practitioner who continuously learns from evidence, patients and service users feedback
- That they demonstrate leadership through developing skilled and competent staff
- The ability to listen and to adapt in response to each situation
- They are an advocate for nurses and nursing.

Nominees for the Brownlee-Silverdale Leadership Award must currently be a registered nurse or midwife from Northern Ireland. Please check that the person you wish to nominate is content for you to nominate them. Nominations must be made by someone who is familiar with the work of the nominee.

Selection will be made by a panel of judges. All awards and prizes are non-transferable. The judges' decision is final.

If short-listed, the candidate will be required to attend an interview on a date to be confirmed by the RCN. The awards ceremony will take place at the Culloden Hotel on 6 June 2019.

Attendance at the interview and awards ceremony is mandatory.

Any candidate who withdraws from the awards ceremony after interview will be disqualified.

Application forms received after the closing date will not be considered.

The RCN reserves the right to disqualify candidates at any stage of the competition should it judge that it is in the best interest of the nursing and midwifery professions to do so.
