2019 Learning in Practice Award Entry Form

The RCN Northern Ireland Nurse of the Year Awards will take place on 6 June 2019 at the Culloden Hotel.

The Learning in Practice Award is open to all registered nurses working in health and social care in Northern Ireland who have provided support for learning and development to a health care assistant, nursing student or registered nurse.

The candidate will be required to demonstrate how they have provided support for learning and development and gone beyond the expectation of the learner or learners they have supported.

Nominations are invited from fellow health care professionals and students.

How to apply

Fill out the application form and complete a 500 word summary showing evidence of:

- the nature of the support provided
- how the learner or learners benefited from the support provided
- how the nominee exceeded the expectations of the learner or learners.

Nominees for the Learning in Practice Award must currently be working as a registered nurse in Northern Ireland. Please check that the person you wish to nominate is content for you to nominate them. Nominations must be made by someone who is familiar with the work of the nominee.

Selection will be made by a panel of judges. All awards and prizes are non-transferable. The judges' decision is final.

Joint nominations will only be considered if they demonstrate clearly that the work undertaken was of a joint nature. Entries of more than two people per nomination will not be accepted.

If short-listed, the candidate will be required to attend an interview on a date to be confirmed by the RCN. The awards ceremony will



take place at the Culloden Hotel on 6 June 2019.

Attendance at the interview and awards ceremony is mandatory.

Any candidate who withdraws from the awards ceremony after interview will be disqualified.

Application forms received after the closing date will not be considered.

The RCN reserves the right to disqualify candidates at any stage of the competition should it judge that it is in the best interest of the nursing and midwifery professions to do so.
