# RCN Wales Nurse of the Year Awards 2024 - Nomination Guidance

The RCN Wales Nurse of the Year Awards will be celebrating its 11th year, hosting it prestigious awards ceremony on Thursday, 21 November 2024 at the Mercure Cardiff Holland House Hotel.

We encourage applications across all areas of nursing as we aspire to be a world-class champion of equality, diversity and inclusion.

The awards are open to registered nurses, nursing students, midwives and health care support workers working in Wales who've led/initiated changes in practice within 18 months of entering the competition. An individual may be nominated for one category only. Joint nominations, of no more than two people, will only be considered if the nominees can clearly demonstrate that the work undertaken was of a joint nature. On the night of the awards an individual Registered Nurse chosen from the category winners will be announced and given the accolade of RCN Wales Nurse of the Year 2024.

Please complete the nomination form in **one** application; you will not be able to save the form. Please ensure you have the workplace and contact details for the nominee and the verifier ready before completing the form. Please tell us the reasons 'why' you have chosen to nominate this individual and provide sufficient evidence of how the nominee meets each of the award criteria. We appreciate this takes time to complete and we would like to highlight the importance of using the full 500words, to help with this there is a 300-word limit. The nominator should clearly set out in their submission how the nominee has given exceptional service as follows:

- address each of the award criteria
- evidence how they exceed expectations; performing at a level above and beyond normal benchmarks.
  - evidence how they have made important and significant contributions in their role.





## **Further Guidance:**

- The closing date for nominations is Sunday 30 June 2024. Nominations received after this date will not be considered.

- We encourage nominations from patients if you need guidance or support to chose a category be sure to contact us via 02920 680746.
- The selection of award finalists will be made by a panel of judges.
- Awards are non-transferable and the judges' decision is final.
- If short-listed, the candidate will be required to attend an interview in **September 2024**.
- Attendance at the interview and awards ceremony is mandatory. Inability to attend will disqualify candidates from the 2024 judging process.
- However, candidates will be encouraged to resubmit their nomination in the following year.
- The RCN reserves the right to disqualify any candidate at any stage of the selection process if it is considered to be in the best interest of the nursing and midwifery profession.
